

2023-24 Application to Conduct Research Change/Renewal Request Form

No research-related activities may continue beyond the expiration date of the Research Notice of Approval (R-NOA) unless an official change/renewal has been granted. A Change/Renewal Request Form must be received 45 days prior to the R-NOA expiration date to ensure adequate review time. As agreed to and signed within the Research Request Form, an Executive Summary or Abstract is still required. It must be submitted no later than 45 calendar days after completion of the study or expired R-NOA. OCPS will communicate determination regarding change/renewal status to the Principal Investigator (PI).
